### ❖ Mode of Selection

Candidate will be selected on the basis of three phase recruitment process in First Phase- (Written test), Second Phase- (PST, PET, Documentation & Descriptive Written Test) and Third Phase- (Final Medical Examination).

**Minimum Qualifying Marks (Direct Entry):-** General/ OBC- 38%, SC/ ST- 33%

**Negative Marking:-** For every multiple- choice question of 2 marks, 0.50 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer.

#### Written Examination (Descriptive Pattern):-

##### For HC/ RO Candidates-

A descriptive paper of maximum **150** marks covering Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Logical Reasoning & English (12<sup>th</sup> Standard). **Max time- 2 Hrs 30 Minutes.**

**Dictation Test-** i.) Dictation test (in English writing) of minimum 100 words:- **50** Marks.

ii.) Paragraph reading (To test proficiency in pronunciation and reading of the candidate):-

**Qualifying in nature.**

##### For HC/ RM Candidates-

A descriptive paper of maximum **200** marks covering Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Logical Reasoning & Electronics Subject (12<sup>th</sup> Standard). **Max time- 3 Hrs.**

#### Final Medical Examination-

*Candidates who qualify all the above tests will be put through a detailed medical examination to assess their fitness. Medical Examination shall be carried out by BSF Medical board of officers.*
